This is especially common in blues based music, and it works great. For example, if the song has the chords A7, D7, E7, you can sound great just using the A minor pentatonic scale.

Soloing with arpeggios, "chord tone targeting", "soloing with triads", etc. all mean the same thing. The idea is to focus on the underlying chords in the chord progression, rather than just paying attention to the overall key.

How to Solo with Triads (aka. "Chord Tone Soloing" or ...

Arpeggios and triads are the chord tones in this way: if you are playing over a C major 7 chord, you are playing chord tones if you play any of the notes from the triad: CEG.

The best way to get good at this chord tone soloing is: 1.) Practice playing over different chord progressions 2.)

Now I want to give you sort of a step-by-step process as to how you can begin to implement the concept of "Chord tone soloing/targeting" into your playing. Note that this isn't just a jazz concept, although jazz guitarists are very much aware of the underlying chords within the progression at all times.

An approach that many great guitarists use to target the right notes over a chord progression is called "Chord Tone Soloing". This means that you don't play in one pentatonic scale over ALL chords, but you connect the chords being played in the progression with a certain scale.

Half-step intervals from chord tones will create tension that clashes (not the best notes). Despite the clashing, tension and release can be used nicely. Some guitarists use it to setup a note that resolves (such as a chord tone). Tension and release is a practice that can create interest in your playing.

An essential skill for any jazz guitarist, and the key to improvising over chord changes, is knowing how to target, start, or resolve your lines to a chord tone. You can target the root of a chord, its 3rd or 5th, you can even target extensions of a chord like its 7th or a 9th, which gives your lines that real jazzy feel.
