"Is four-dimensionalism as defined consistent with both presentism and eternalism? Four-dimensionalism is the thesis that persisting objects are temporally extended and do not wholly exist at any temporal location. Most four-dimensionalists (in the form of perdurantists) are eternalists. That is hardly surprising.
