Toyota 1ZZ-FE Timing Chain Marks 1.8L. Lewis. Moderator. The problem most people run into with these timing chains on these 1ZZ-FE engines is that there are no marks to use as a reference other than the marks on the Intake/Exhaust gears and the marks on the chain. Here are some pics of the timing chain set up at TDC.

The 1ZZ-FE engine features a die-cast aluminum engine block with thin press-fit cast iron cylinder liners and aluminum cylinder head with two overhead camshafts (DOHC) and four valves per cylinder (16 in total). For the 1ZZ-FE engine, Toyota's 'variable valve timing with intelligence' (VVT-i) provided continual variations of the intake valve timing according to engine speed, throttle position, inlet camshaft angle, engine coolant temperature and intake air volume.

The 1ZZ-FE was a 1.8-liter inline four-cylinder gasoline engine out of Toyota's ZZ engine family. Replacing the old 1.8L 7A-FE engines, it was first introduced in 1998, and in December 2007, its production already was discontinued. This engine was offered mostly for the front-wheel drive vehicles such as the Toyota Corolla or Toyota Celica GT, but also for the rear-wheel-drive Toyota MR2 Spyder and Lotus Elise.

Light valves are the engine's essential part and the timing belt was replaced with a timing chain. All the 1ZZ stock injectors are 255 cc. The 1ZZ throttle body has a diameter of 54 mm. The 1ZZ-FE engine is not equipped with hydraulic lifters, so you have to adjust the valves once per 60,000...

The first 1ZZ-FE for overseas market (type '97 for ZZE110, produced until 08.1999) have fixed timing without VVT, but type '98 was already equipped with VVT-i (Variable Valve Timing). Sprocket with VVT actuator is mounted to intake camshaft, variable timing range - 40°.

The 1zz & 2zz engine are high revving engines, so to get the full performance out of them they need to be revved high. As I said earlier the Variable Valve Timing does not engage until 6.4k revs. This is the point when the engine is giving it's full performance.

Toyota ZZ engine. The Toyota ZZ engine family is a straight-4 piston engine series. The ZZ series uses a die-cast aluminum engine block with thin press-fit cast iron cylinder liners, and aluminum DOHC 4-valve cylinder heads. The camshafts are chain-driven. The two 1.8 L members of the family, the 1ZZ and 2ZZ, use different bore and stroke.

The old timing chain tensioner on the 1ZZ-FE 1.8 liter engine is located on the passenger side at the rear of the engine block. See the picture above for a better idea of the location. The green arrow points to the upper of the two 10mm nuts holding it in place.

The Toyota 3ZZ-FE engine used Multipoint fuel injection system, VVT-i (Variable Valve Timing with intelligence). The is equipped with DIS-4 - with individual ignition coil for each spark plug. Compression ratio rating is 10.5:1. Bore and stroke are 79.0 mm (3.11 in) and 81.5 mm (3.21 in), respectively.

The Toyota 1ZZ-FE is rather obviously the first engine in the Toyota ZZ family. It's a 1.8L with a 79mm bore, 91.5mm stroke and a 10:1 compression. You can tell from those specifications alone that this engine is fairly torquey thanks to the long stroke and provides great efficiency with that high compression ratio.

The 2ZR-FE engine took a middle place in the power range of the ZR family, between the 1ZR and 3ZR engines. This 1.8-liter four-cylinder gasoline engine was introduced in 2007 and rapidly became an alternative for the 1ZZ-FE power unit. Toyota produces some different variants of the 2ZR depending on vehicle models (for example, regular Toyota Corolla or hybrid Toyota Prius) and markets (Europe ...

Timing marks 2000 Toyota corolla (4E-FE/ 4A-FE/ 5A-FE) Align the crankshaft pulley mark with the 0 mark of timing case. The camshaft sprocket is at TDC when the hole in the sprocket lines up with the notch in the bearing cap
